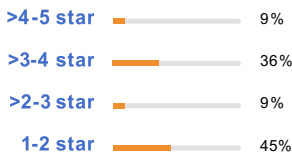

**I am absolutely satisfied because of good teachers, good placements and good infrastructure.**

**Placements:** About 90% of the students from our course got placed. The highest salary offered is Rs. 55,000 per month, while the lowest salary offered is Rs. 35,000 per month. All good companies visited our college for placements. About 60% of the students got placed in the campus interviews, and everything is perfect in our college.

**Infrastructure:** Our college has one of the best infrastructures in Coimbatore, and the facilities are also good. Our college provides Wi-Fi facility, labs, classrooms, library, canteen and all other facilities. Hostel and mess facilities are really good.

**Faculty:** Teachers here are really helpful and have good teaching skills to give the best solutions. They are perfectly qualified, very knowledgeable and provide good teaching. The course curriculum is well relevant.

### **Dissatisfied with the college life. There was less enjoyment and more academic pressure.**

**Placements:** Placements are provided by the college, and they are mainly provided to CSE and EC departments. The companies that come to recruit are mostly IT companies. Placements for the mechanical and civil departments are very low. Companies related to the mechanical and civil branches do not visit the college for placements.

**Infrastructure:** The infrastructure of our college is satisfactory. The front view of the college is very attractive. Classrooms are moderate, and there is a good library. The canteen is neat, and the food offered is fine. The college has all kinds of labs, but maintenance of the mechanical lab machines is poor. The ground is fine but not great. There are hostels for boys and girls, and the food provided in the hostel mess is adjustable.

**Faculty:** There are faculty members for all the subjects. Most of the faculty members are well-experienced and have good knowledge of the subjects. They are also good at teaching. Some of the faculty members need to improve more in teaching. All of them are hardworking and very sincere to get good results for students.

**Other:** Lots of events are conducted in the college like departmental functions, workshops, sports, and arts. The departmental function is the biggest event conducted; it may be conducted for 2 to 3 days. Many workshops are also organised. Students can only watch sports even though they want to participate. The college does not provide good support for activities related to arts.

### **Good but average faculty and poor facilities.**

**Placements:** The placements here are too bad and poor. No good companies come for




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placement purpose. Only placements are given into business processing organisation. All faculty members speak highly about placement cell, but nothing is given. Too bad aptitude classes for the placement related concerns.

**Infrastructure:** The whole infrastructures seem good. It has a good structure with 2 blocks mainly a-block and b-block. The campus and college infrastructure is well-maintained by the staff. It also has a hostel which is 100m apart from PPG institute. It also has an automatic teller machine of the Indian Bank in the front of the successful infrastructure.

**Faculty:** The faculty members are not at all good. There are some good faculty members, but most of them leave the college after one or two years of work. There is no consistency faculty in this college. The course curriculum will surely get completed before the exam, but it won't be properly covered. They are not as much interested in their profession.

**Other:** It is 15 minutes of drive from Coimbatore international airport. The college has an Indian bank automatic teller machine nearby. It is 45 minutes from Gandhipuram main bus stand. There is no transport facility available on the route. It is a 5-minute drive from the Kaapikada bus stand.

**In the year 2016, approximately, 60% of the students got placed.**

**Placements:** Yearly once, the college management calls companies from different sectors like BPO, KPO, IT, startups for on-campus drives. 30% of the students got selected. We recommended the college to conduct placements frequently. So, students can be familiar with interviews.

**Infrastructure:** Overall, the infrastructure is good. The Wi-Fi facility is restricted in our college. Hostels are good in accommodation, but food seems to be not bad. We have a playground, gym, multiple labs and RD labs. There is a newly opened mechatronics lab for research purpose.

**Faculty:** In my course curriculum, faculty members are quite good at handling students and teaching. Management is also good. They helped me a lot with my studies. In my department, there are 7 faculty members for 54 students. We got industry exposure as well, and it is most useful in our curriculum.

### **To be a good engineer, choose the right place. Consider these things and self-analyse.**

**Placements:** We were 51 in our class out of which 30 students got placed, but no one got into the core field. Companies like Tech Mahindra, IDBI, KGISL were brought to our on-campus placements but the job role was Customer support associates, BPOs and marketing. The same thing happened to our seniors (100+ in their batch). Core companies didn't visit our campus and we were not well trained to approach core companies. One of my senior (2016 batch) got placed in Zoho International with the salary package of 40,000 per month. Faculty members guided us to approach for internships. A few went on their own try (no stipends were given). Still, now we have the nightmare to work in a core company. The conclusion is that placement opportunities to my batch were moderate (but no core companies).


**Infrastructure:** Our college campus is about 8-10 acres in area. There are two fully constructed buildings, one for business school and another one is for engineering which are sufficient for the student count. The outer look is good and classrooms are spacious with fans and windows. There were no projectors mounted to the walls but when required brought from lab during seminars. Wi-Fi was available but passwords were restricted (if needed, a permission letter has to be acquired for using Wi-Fi). The central library is available with needful books, daily newspapers in English, Tamil and Malayalam, the latest journals and systems with the internet connection. Since our chairman is running a hospital at a distance of 7 km away. Medical facilities were good in all the aspects. sports opportunities were good but the trainer is not good to train the players. Cultural events were conducted periodically. The hostel room is available as 4 people sharing a room. The mess food is not good, maybe now it has changed. Canteen food quality is moderate. There are 4 laboratories, 2 labs with 25+ systems each and another 2 for hardware. A development center with Texas Instruments experimental kits was recently opened. Playgrounds were not sufficient and the library has to be improved.

**Faculty:** Faculty members were not very much technically strong. sometimes the same faculty was given two subjects to handle. But they were patient and helpful in clearing doubts. Insufficient faculty members were there in all the departments. The teaching



method was poor since the management was keen on results. They just focussed on the examinations. They pretend to be teaching in all technical aspects but they just train us for the University exams. Internal exams were totally wasted. We were not exposed to in-plant training but we can go out of our own interest, permission and on duty will be provided.

**Other:** The management is fully keen on results and fees. Concessions for toppers and full tuition fee-free options are given by the college trustees to the economically backwards students. I recommend them to focus on training students with experiments and expose them to industrial training. I also recommend creating an opportunity for student entrepreneurs and to develop their ideas on campus, so that the student's confidence level be increased and can be self-employed or can become a successful entrepreneur.

**In 2016, satisfied because of care and support of faculty, good infrastructure and management.**

**Placements:** In 2016, more than 5 companies came for placements. It is purely in IT companies and BPO companies. In my college, they offered us to go for an off-campus drive wherever held in Tamil Nadu. Placements are overall good for circuit branches but non-circuit branches have very rare placements.

**Infrastructure:** The infrastructure is good because all departments have separate building blocks along with the lab rooms. Overall, the college and hostel are connected by Wi-Fi. We can access it anytime and anywhere. The hostel food quality is good and the hostel rooms are good and clean.

**Faculty:** In my CSE department, most of the faculty members are quite good in teaching and encourage the students well. They will conduct special coaching classes for the weak students in their studies especially mathematics. In my class, the total number of students is 53 with 8 faculty members. In my college, they are arranging a scholarship for poor students and I hope this will help the other students as well.



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
