NEET UG Counselling Procedure for State Medical Private Colleges

The NEET UG counselling for state medical government colleges is conducted by the respective state authorities. Each state follows a similar process but may have specific variations in the details. Here's a comprehensive overview of the counselling process for various states, including flow charts and key steps.

Registration

- Visit the official website of the state counselling authority.
 Log in to the state counselling portal using credentials.
- Click on the 'New Registration' link.
- Enter required details like NEET Roll Number, Application
 Modify and rearrange choices if needed. Number, Name, Date of Birth, and Security Pin.
- Pay the registration fee online.

Seat Allotment

- The state authority processes the seat allotment based on Report to the allotted college with the allotment letter and NEET rank, choices filled, reservation criteria, and availability of seats.
- The result of the seat allotment is published on the state counselling website.
- Download the allotment letter from the portal.

Subsequent Rounds (Second Round, Mop-**Up Round, Stray Vacancy Round)**

- Fresh registration for new candidates.
- Already registered candidates can directly proceed to choice filling.
- Follow the same procedure as the first round for choice filling, locking, and seat allotment.

Choice Filling and Locking

- Fill in choices of colleges and courses as per preference.
- Lock the choices before the deadline.

Reporting to Allotted College

- required documents.
- Complete the admission formalities at the college.
- If satisfied with the allotment, complete the admission process.
- If not satisfied, participate in the next round of counselling.

Second Round Seat Allotment	Allotment of seats for the second round	August
Reporting to Allotted College	Report to the college with documents for second round	August- September
Mop-up Round	Conducted if seats remain vacant after the second round	September
Final Reporting	Final reporting to allotted colleges after mop-up round	September
