

Bachelor in Business Administration (B.B.A.)



LIBRARY

We take pride in a well equipped Department of Information Science and Library Science with 60898 books, 121 journals, 110 magazines, 22 newspapers. We also have E-Library with 361 E-journals freely accessible. JNC library is an institutional member of DELNET (Developing Library Network), IIMA. JNC also takes pride in having current awareness section, Combo pack on skill developments with books and CD's and a Liguaphone in foreign languages is made available for students. Library is equipped with radiofrequency identification device and CCTV with digital and Smart ID card facility.

The college library is open from 7.45am to 6.00pm on all working days, except on Saturday when it is closed at 4.00pm. Students can use the photocopying machine, internet facilities, access CDs and printer to obtain hard copies.

CLASSROOMS

The classrooms are well-ventilated, spacious with comfortable furniture. They are equipped with multimedia, smart boards, Wifi and audio-visual equipments like LCD projectors and advanced sound systems to facilitate effective learning. They are designed to promote maximum interaction between the faculty and the students.

BANK

South Indian Bank is within the campus which offers regular bank services. The bank is open from 11.00 am to 3.00 pm from Monday to Friday and 10.30 am to 12.00 pm on first and third Saturday.

HOSTEL

Away from home, with an eco-friendly ambience, the hostel students enjoy a clean environment with wholesome nutritious food and safe accommodation under the guardianship of the Hostel Warden.





SCHOLARSHIPS

Keeping in mind the mission of reaching out of the poor and needy, the under privileged and marginalized in the society, the Student Welfare Committee provides textbooks, personal counseling and arranges scholarships, medical facilities, workshops and remedial classes.

Scholarships like Sanchi Honnamma, C.V. Raman, JNC Alumni, Society of St. Joseph, Shri Sultan Chand Memorial Scholarship are awarded in addition to SC/ ST scholarship, Defence Scholarship and Nagaland Scholarship. Regular remedial classes are held for the needy and SC/ST students with the help of bright students under the supervision of staff members.

Students of the final year degree with brilliant academic records, having secured first class in the University exams, are eligible to apply for the Merit Scholarships. Special Financial Aid is offered to the students of economically backward class, having a good academic record.

Students who excel in sports, extra curricular and co-curricular activities are offered scholarships at different levels.



PARENT-MENTOR MEETING

The Mentor system is an endeavour by the staff to provide a support system for students. Each student is assigned a mentor, who records the student's progress over three years of the degree course.

A Parent-Mentor meeting is held every year with the objective of establishing healthy interaction between parents and teachers to promote the welfare of the students, to assess the student's potential, progress and deal with their problems.






CONVOCATION
