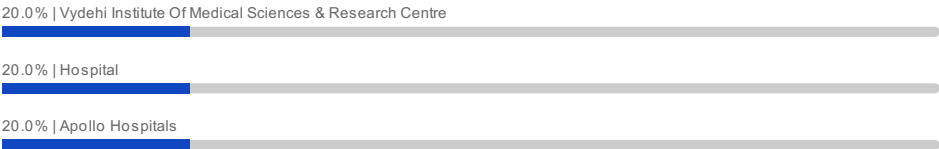

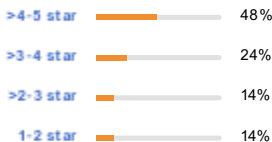

Placements: In our college, there are 250 students in a batch. Career opportunities are very good with very useful teaching and guidance. Everything is great if we work for the minimum.

Infrastructure: College facilities are good. The infrastructure of the college is fine but hostel is horrible. I won't suggest anyone to join this hostel as it is very horrible. There are common washrooms for 3 sharing rooms with a fee

of Rs.1 lakh 70 thousand rupees, which isn't worth it. Washrooms are very bad with poor hygiene. The food is also not good.

Faculty: Teaching-wise, this is the best college as they give individual attention to almost all the students. It has very friendly teachers, knowledgeable teachers with 3D classes, and with medimagic app subscription, they explain concepts in depth which is very helpful. We can easily pass as they train us very well during class hours and practical classes, but there are no extracurricular activities. It is a studies-oriented system. From my batch of 250 students, 75 students failed during their regular exams and are taking supplementary exams now in which the majority of the students will clear the subjects. This course is mainly for those who are dedicated to their studies. I recommend this college for education purposes, it's the best institute.

It has a good infrastructure with quality education but lack of extracurriculars.

Placements: We had 250 students enrolled in year 2019. Out of which, the current strength dropped to 223 after 1st year. The strength is expected to drop again after 2nd year exams. Students are not categorised based on NEET marks, and all are treated equally. The only difference is fee payment per year with government students paying the least and management quota students paying the most. The college itself will offer internship opportunities, and students can also opt for external exams such as USMLE and PLAB.

Infrastructure: Classrooms for 1,2,4 year are fully air-conditioned with functional computers and screens. However 3rd year classrooms could be compared to a government school, perhaps worse. Hostel is terrible, and I would not recommend joining. There are no sports or games. There are no fests or anything outside of academics.

Faculty: Teachers are intelligent. They do teach those who are willing to listen. With the help of the newly based CBME course students are offered greater clinical knowledge which will eventually help them become competent medical professionals. The teachers are very accessible and respond appropriately to the initiative. The internals are quite difficult and are comparatively harder than the final exams which allow students to better prepare.

Other: I chose this course due to my love for medical life as well as legacy student. I love studying how the body works and the surgical techniques involved. I wish our college would include fests or anything resembling extracurricular activities. There are no sports or games or annual days which is depressing. This is the only thing I would change about our college.

Placements: Our college has very good job offers. As the course of MBBS is professional. There is nothing sorted as a package for a UG MBBS student. There are PG courses available for our course at a good level. The internship involves serving Vydehi hospital for a year where students will get to see many different patients every day.



Infrastructure: The infrastructure is very good. The laboratories are well-equipped and there is a well-established library. The classrooms are of big capacity fitting more than 500 students at once. The hostel is strict and the food is average. There is a basketball, volleyball, football, and cricket field with a small gym so the college is good at its infrastructure. Review of Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre.

Placements: Placements are for students who clear their exams and complete the course without any backlogs. Almost 95-98% of students get placement here. The highest salary offered for an intern is Rs. 24,000 per annum if only the intern is an hostler or else the lowest salary is not offered for an intern. Recruiting is based on the scores you get in your final year. If you score well, then you can get a chance of doing internship in government medical colleges.

Infrastructure: For the college, I would rate 4.5 stars because the infrastructure is good enough. There are also research labs and A medical simulation facility in our college. It also has a museum of specimens which are beautiful worth seeing, and you will learn a lot from the facilities. Wi-Fi is not provided for the students but is available only for the staff members. Classrooms are huge and up to the standards. It also has its own book reading room for students. The library has a good amount of standard books to the latest edition now, and they are building a new one on the 3rd floor beside the reading room, which is even huge and silent. I did not stay in the hostel. It is not worth the money, and you are giving almost like 2 lacs per annum, and it is not even worth a single star because you find rats in your food in a mess. There is no clean water to drink, and the bathrooms are not cleanly maintained. A room is cleaning done once a week. There are no laundry facilities in the hostel. Rules are strict, and you will feel like it is a jail. I suggest you don't join either by mistake or someone's opinion. It has a gym with dumbbells, and a reading room is the only good thing. In the TV room, the TV does not work. For me, food poisoning happened within a week of joining the hostel. It has the worst sports facilities, and students, by their own money, get the ground ready for playing sports. There is no sports management in this college.

Faculty: Teachers from various colleges like AFMC, BMC, MSRMC, KIMS are good and very helpful in their studies. Just be obedient to them. There is also a mentorship program through which you can deal with your problems and chill out with your mentor and feel free to talk about yourself. I think the course curriculum is relevant, and it makes the students get ready for the future because there is an environment created for the student to be successful. Internals starting will be easier, and later on, it goes hard. The minimum percentage required to pass is 50% in each subject or each paper of the subject, and it is the same as applicable to RGUHS criteria.

Other: I have chosen this course because it is the only way you can make yourself satisfied by helping others. The best thing about our course is it is worth working for. I wish the course duration should be a little bit more in the fourth year because we can get exposed to more clinical cases of different varieties. I suggest you do not keep any expectations for fests and events because it is all about you investing. You can create your own event outside the campus surroundings. There is no Xerox shop, and the one inside the hospital is charging a lot for a sheet. There is no printout facility inside or outside the campus. Rest everything is available. In a few more years, there will also be a metro connecting to the Vydehi hospital stop in the purple line. The college bus facility is also currently available to Baiyappanahalli. Extracurricular activities are not conducted in the college, so do not expect anything.
